

NEBRASKA JUNIOR ANGUS ASSOCIATION STATE SHOW RULES

ELIGIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS AND ENTRIES

- 1) Exhibitors must be members of the NJAA, and must be 8 years old but not yet 21 years old on January 1 of the current year.
- 2) Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor, the name of an immediate family member of the exhibitor, or the name of the firm in which the exhibitor or immediate family member holds ownership.
- 3) Exhibitors in the bred-and owned categories must be the breeder and first and continuous owner of the animal entered.
- 4) Exhibitors may show up to two entries in each of the categories but may not show more than a total of three heifers between the owned and bred-and-owned heifer classes.
- 5) Original registration certificates must be presented at check-in. all tattoos must be readable

CLASSES

- 1) The classes will be the same as they are for the National Junior Angus Show. There will be classes for bred-and-owned heifers, bred and owned bulls, owned heifers, registered steers and cow/calf pairs
- 2) There will be an additional class for best pair of heifers.
- 3) There will be a Supreme Heifer Champion and Reserve Champion selected from the Champion and Reserve Champion Owned and Bred-and-Owned Heifers.

SHOWMANSHIP

- 1) Showmanship classes will be divided according to age as of January 1 of the current year not exceeding 21 years of age, following the National Junior Angus Association's age divisions for contests. The Junior Division 13 and under, Intermediate Division 14-17 and Senior Division 18 thru age 21
- 2) Two contestants will be selected to represent Nebraska at the National Junior Angus Showmanship Contest from the Senior Division of the state show. If either of the two selected has previously attended the National Showmanship Contest then the next contestant in line will be selected to participate. In order to represent Nebraska at the National Showmanship contest the exhibitor must be a Junior or Life Member of the American Angus Association, an active member of the Nebraska Junior Angus Association (active member being defined as having shown in the Nebraska Junior Angus

State Show, a National Junior Angus Regional Show or National Junior Angus Show with one of the past two years, current year excluded, with their membership dues paid and his or her immediate family must be a member of the Nebraska Angus Association. All fees must be paid before entering the contest. Contestants by entering agree to abide by the rules.

4 th Place in Class	4 points
5 th Place in Class	3 points
Exhibitor Awards	1 point
